- V. ANNOUNCEMENTS AND CORRESPONDENCE
  - a. All In, Matt daily
    - i. Matt Daily shared that the All In committee is looking for an ASISU representative to be a part of this committee with the goal of getting more students to participate in both local and national elections.
      - a. Senator Jorgenson volunteered to be the ASISU representative on this committee.
  - b. Spirit Bus Funding, Franklin Spicer
    - i. The spirit bus funding would be used to rent a bus to take some students to the rival ISU and U of I game on November 18<sup>th</sup> in Moscow. They would rent a 54 person bus from Teton Stage Lines. Athletics is providing \$1,000 and the requested funding from ASISU would cover the bus rental as well as ticket to the actual game.

    - Jessica Spellman presented to the Senate on the scopes, research, prevention and support regarding suicide. The goal of this presentation is to make the conversation about suicide easier to have.

The main two issues are housing as well as mental health issues.
