Funding for this project will be put in place and implemented all over campus. President Watts shared that in Leadership Council this morning the emergency evacuation systems across campus were evaluated and there is also a taskforce being developed to assess the online consumption levels of Google Drive, Box and Microsoft Word. The goal of this taskforce is to lower the cost of these online platforms. In the faculty Senate Resolution 622 was approved and now will go on to get approved by the Academic Senate. She also shared that the top 5 presidential candidates have been announced. Regarding this decision there will be open forums from 9:45-10:45 am everyday next week in the Bengal Theater. Following this there will also be receptions and presentations every night beginning at 6 pm in the Bengal Alumni Center.
