THE HIGHLIGHTS

- The survey included graduates from spring, summer and fall 2022 graduations
- Graduates were surveyed over a 6-month period, which conforms with the National Association of Colleges and Employers standard
- 75.2% of respondents are working or continuing their education within Idaho
- 77.1 % of respondents who participated in a Career Path Internship felt the experience was beneficial in their job search
- 63.3 % of respondents indicated they held a full-time or part-time position, internship, or volunteering experience while in college

Full-time: 90.3%

Part-time: 9.7%

The emailed survey was sent to a total of 2,641 spring, summer, and fall graduates / 55 percent response rate. 19 percent are knowledge responses from LinkedIn. Unless otherwise specified, all information presented is a combination of undergraduate and graduate data.


