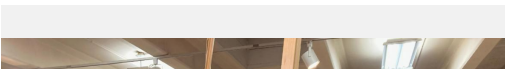

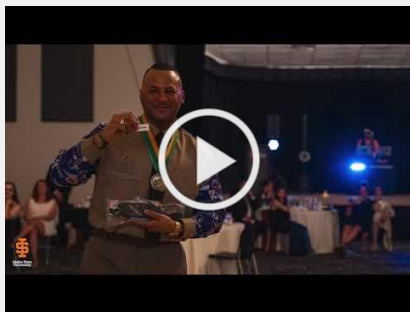
Social Work Education Across the State

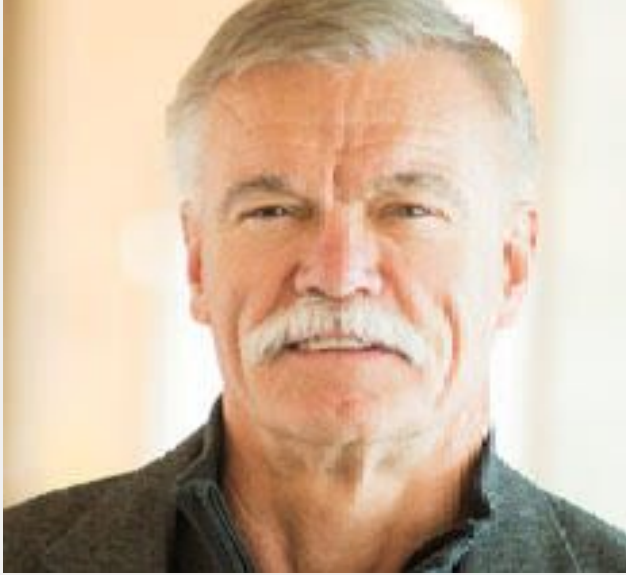
