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Criminal History: You may be unable to pursue the OTA program if you have any criminal history.

Acceptance is contingent on successful completion of drug screening, up to date immunizations, and current CPR certification. You will receive further instructions on these once you are competitively accepted.

Separate OTA application: found online, is due beginning of January. Yearly selection is based on grades in applicable classes and courses completed by application deadline.

Successful completion of 40 hours of observation. Twenty hours in physical disabilities such as inpatient, outpatient rehab, home health, skilled nursing, and 20 hours in pediatrics, dementia, behavioral health, psychosocial settings.

Two recommendation forms that must be from the field of occupational therapy. This could be someone you know from your observation hours, volunteer time, or work.
