Student Essays must be handwritten; the two people applicants ask to complete the **Application References** should NOT be friends nor have familial relations with the student.

Accepted Students will need to complete a medical exam, be up to date with immunizations; provide verification of current health insurance; be CPR certified (available via ISU Continuing Educ./Workforce Training); complete HIPAA training (via ISU); pass a background check; complete a negative drug test.
