#### I. POLICY STATEMENT

Anyone using controlled substances at ISU in research must obtain the appropriate federal and state individual licenses and registrations and adhere to the applicable state and federal regulatory requirements when working with these agents. Procedures for ordering, storing and destroying these agents can be found on the Research Outreach and Compliance website.

#### II. AUTHORITY AND RESPONSIBILITIES

All ISU faculty or staff obtaining the required licenses and registrations are responsible to follow all applicable federal, state and ISU regulatory requirements pertaining to the use of controlled substances in research. The Office for Research Outreach and Compliance will be responsible for tracking and monitoring such use.

#### III. DEFINITIONS

**Controlled Substance -** Any substance listed in the Controlled Substances Act, Code of Federal Regulations (21 CFR, part 1300 to end) and the <u>Idaho Title 37.27 Article II</u>.
