Admission to the Social Work Program

Application for admission to the Social Work Program is required of all students desiring to progress toward a social work major. Students may apply to the major at the completion of the sophomore year and after completing or with current enrollment in required prerequisite goal areas and courses. Students accepted into the Social Work program will be notified prior to Spring pre-registration.

Students are admitted based on a variety of factors (i.e., GPA. written statement, background check results, prior courses completed, etc.).

Following acceptance into the Social Work Major, the student must maintain a 2.5 GPA and abide by the policies and procedures outlined in the Social Work <u>Student Handbook</u>.

All social work majors are required to meet the above standards before they may enroll in upper division social work courses (those numbered 3000 and above).

The Social Work Program does not grant credit for previous life or work experience.

7. Information on our Background Check Policy

A criminal background check is no longer required as part of the admissions process. Students should be advised that a criminal background may create barriers to obtaining a license to practice social work and the rules and regulations regarding licensure for those with a criminal background vary by state. Please refer to the licensing board in the state where you plan to seek a license upon graduation to review state policies. Students may be required to obtain a background check when seeking practicum placement; if a student opts to seek a placement in a facility that requires background checks they will be required to do so. If a student does not wish to submit to a background check they will need to seek a practicum placement in a setting where one is not required. If a student's unwillingness to submit to a background check, or if a student's criminal background prohibits them from securing a practicum placement the student's progress in the program may be delayed and/or they may be dismissed from the BASW program.
