Apply to be a member of the Student Activities Board (SAB)

The SAB is a group of students who work together to plan campus events at Idaho State University. Positions available are Bengal Pride Programmer, Entertainment Programmer, Family Events Programmer, and SAB Director. A monthly stipend of \$440 is paid to SAB Programmers and \$660 to the SAB Director.

Expectations of Student Activities Board Programmers:

- ❖ Applications must be full-time students, carrying a minimum of 12 credit hours.
- ❖ Applicants must have and maintain a minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA throughout the selection process and the length of commitment.
- ❖ Must be able to complete 8 office hours per week.
- ❖ Must attend all SAB planning meetings.
- ❖ Must attend all SAB events.
- ❖ Student must be able to commit to being a full-time member of the SAB for the entire school year, August 2024-May 2025.
- ❖ Must be available this summer in Pocatello.
- ❖ Applications are due March 15, 2024 by 5:00pm.

Position Descriptions
