THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS MDAnderson CATALYST Summer Training Programs Cancer Center

The CATALYST program (Cancer Advanced Training and Learning for Young Scientists) is an umbrella program that brings together 17 unique academic research summer programs for students at various levels, from high school through graduate and medical school.

For example, the <u>UPWARDS program</u> within the CATALYST program is a ten-week paid research program designed for outstanding underserved students who are interested in pursuing a career in cancer research. The program provides an interactive and fulfilling research experience in cutting-edge labs, where they will interact daily with faculty, postdoctoral fellows, and graduate students. Students will attend scientific lectures, seminars and career development events, and will have the opportunity to present their work at a poster session at the end of the ten-week program.

Students will receive a stipend up to \$6,800 (\$680 per full week worked) for the ten-week program. Housing will be paid by the students from these funds. Paychecks will be issued on the 5th and the 20th of each month, deducting the required federal tax.

Students must have completed a Bachelor's degree before pursuing the PhD Dual Degree to begin the program in the first semester of their PharmD year, however; students need to be accepted into the PharmD program first and meet any other requirements.
